



DRIVING WITH CONTROLLED SPEED RULES

1. The goal of this event is to drive a **TEAM** through and around obstacles simulating driving through a town to make a delivery on time and safely.
2. One safety assistant will accompany the driver.
3. The Show will provide identical wagons.
4. The course may include, but is not limited to, such obstacles as serpentine course of pylons, complete circles to left and/or right, an alleyway, a simulated loading dock to back up to, and precise stopping.
5. Accuracy is most important, with time being used only as a tiebreaker.
6. Touching or moving an obstacle will result in penalty points.
7. Time in the course area is restricted to THREE (3) minutes.
8. The function of the safety assistant is to ride on the wagon and come to the aid of the driver only if an emergency should arise. Should the assistant touch the lines or in any way speak or signal the driver or team, the driver will be disqualified in the event.
9. Teams are to negotiate the course as quickly as possible without breaking out of a working/extended trot.
10. Walking is considered a break in gait.
11. Loping is not allowed and is grounds for disqualification.
12. NOTE: This class is one of the four designated as a Master Teamster classes and maybe entered as an individual Open Class or as part of the Master Teamster.
