
LOG SKIDDING



LOG SKIDDING RULES

- 1. This is a timed event.
- 2. There is a 5-minute time limit for the course.
- 3. Skidding two 16-foot logs through a designated course consisting of pylons and an alley. Precision and control of the **TEAM** and logs is the primary goal, simulating a logging activity.
- 4. The driver must either ride on the logs or walk. He/she may not do both.
- 5. The Driver must follow the designed pattern.
- 6. The Driver must not allow any part of himself/herself, logs, team or doubletree to touch a pylon or break a barrier.
- 7. Each touch of pylon or break of barrier will result in a penalty of 5 seconds added to the driver's time
- 8. NOTE: This class is one of the four designated as a Master Teamster class. It may be entered as an Individual Open Class or as part of the Master Teamster.
