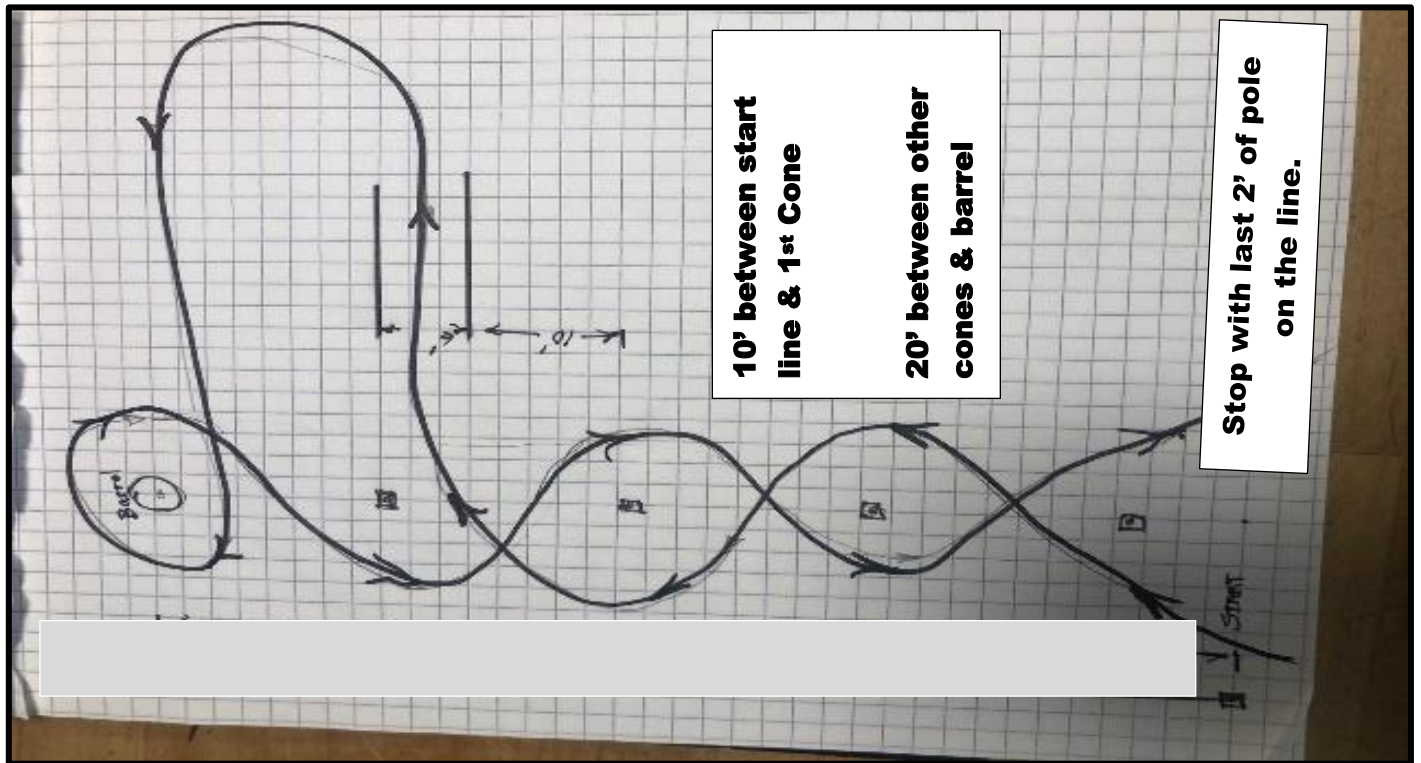


## LOG SKIDDING



### LOG SKIDDING RULES

1. This is a timed event.
2. There is a **5-minute time limit** for the course.
3. Skidding two 16-foot logs through a designated course consisting of cones and an alley. Precision and control of the **TEAM** and logs is the primary goal, simulating a logging activity.
4. The driver must either ride on the logs or walk. He/she may not do both.
5. The Driver must follow the designed pattern.
6. The Driver must not allow any part of himself/herself, logs, team or doubletree to touch a cone or break a barrier.
7. Each touch of cone or break of barrier will result in a penalty of 5 seconds added to the driver's time
8. Off Course results in a Disqualification (DQ)
9. NOTE: This class is one of the four designated as a Master Teamster class. It may be entered as an Individual Open Class or as part of the Master Teamster.

#### Equipment:

- 6 – Cones
- 1 Barrel
- 2- Logs
- 2 Rails
